

Waste minimisation policy

Pritchitts is registered to the environmental standard BS EN ISO 14001:2004 and we work to ensure that all aspects of operation have a minimal impact on the environment, both locally and globally. This is clearly stated in our environmental policy

As a company we are committed to sustainable waste management and continually improve our waste minimisation strategy throughout all aspects of our operations. We have implemented a hierarchy of waste management system to achieve the following

- Divert 90% of waste from landfill by mid 2010
- Prevent/reduce waste creation
- Re-use as much material as possible
- Recycle as much material as possible

To achieve these goals we shall:

- Implement good waste management practices
- Invest in the best available technologies
- Educate and train all employees on waste minimisation and recycling techniques
- Work with suppliers to reduce packaging coming into the company
- Minimise waste by working alongside the National Industrial Symbiosis Programme
- Organise our waste generation at all points of the manufacturing and distribution and disposal routes as best as possible
- Purchase as many materials that are from a recycled source that is reasonably practical.
- Promote the economy of use of all paper based materials on site
- Match and, where possible, exceed regulatory demands

Pritchitts shall continue to comply with its duty of care with regards to waste legislation and ensure that all documentation is maintained accordingly.
